Soaring Scores

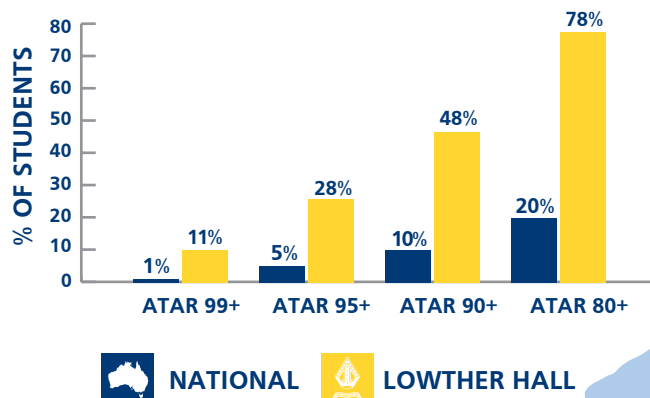

ATAR Scores 2019 – 2022



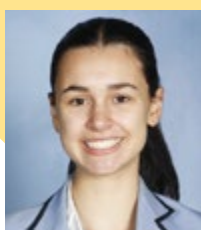
Lowther Hall ATAR Scores 2022

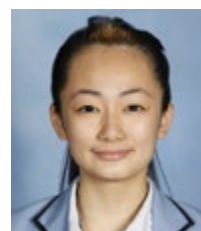

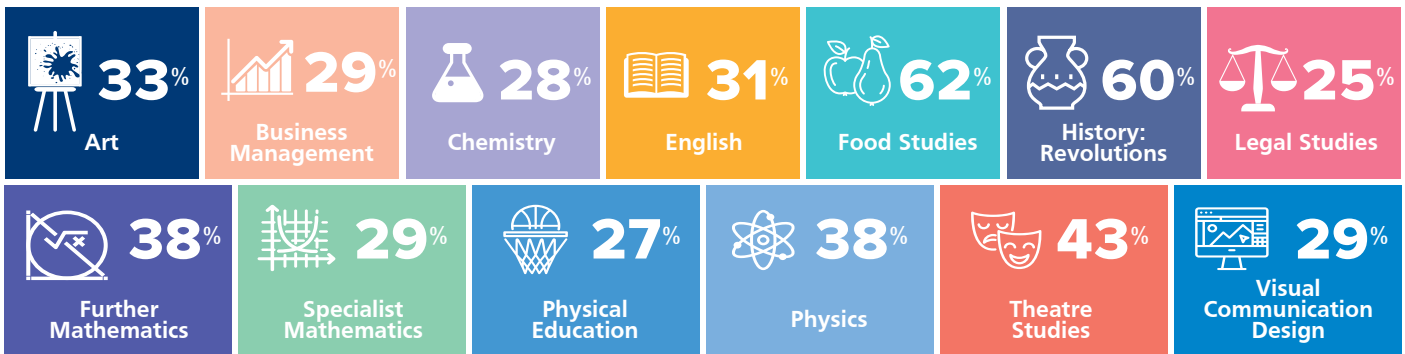
